Is dependent on God's energy

Is built on relationship

Seeks to accomplish God's purposes and meet the needs of people

**2:6-19, Problem: the "Not Christ" life (2:6, as then....)

The goal defined, 6-7 (stated positively)

The threat described—false approaches, 8 (stated negatively)

The solution developed—Christ, 9-15 (stated positively)

See Christ's fullness and live out that fullness

Know Christ's forgiveness

Imitate Christ's faithfulness

Experience freedom

The danger detailed--false measurements, 16-19 (stated negatively)

Focusing on the shadow, not reality

Allowing false judgments/controls

Disconnectedness from Christ

Seeking unhealthy growth

Exalting human commands

Unrestrained indulgence

***2:20-3:4 Focus: Christ (2:20, 3:1, if then....)

Past—you died with Christ, you died to the world (sun-)

Present—why keep on as though your life still depended on the world

Past—you have been raised with Christ, remember that fact (sun-)

Present-keep on....

Seeking things above where Christ is

Thinking on things above, not earthly

Reason: Past and present summarized (sun-)

Future—Anticipate the result

Life is not "bios" but "zoa" (sun-)
